
## Autumn Term 2021

Could we please ask that unless you are toilet training, you provide nappies that are not pull ups so that the children do not need to be stripped in order to change their nappy.

Please let us know straight away if there is any change to your contact details.

There is a one-way system in place to make the roads outside school safe for the children during drop off and collection time. Please pass the school on your left, by driving down Brookfield Road and then School Drive and out along Westbrook End.

The car park is only for school and preschool staff. Please park on the road and walk up to the preschool.
